

This classic is a three-act play by Henrik Ibsen. Its first performance was in 1879. The play espouses a critical attitude toward 19th-century marriage norms. It aroused great controversy at the time because it ends with the protagonist, Nora, leaving her husband and children because she wants to discover herself. Ibsen was inspired by the belief that a woman cannot be herself in modern society, since it is an exclusively male society, with laws made by men and with prosecutors and judges who assess feminine conduct from a masculine standpoint. This edition has been attractively formatted to provide a pleasant reading experience.
